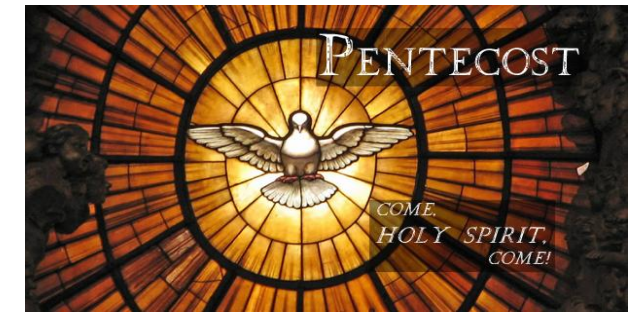

The Election of a new Bishop for the Diocese of Toronto

On June 9, 2018, the Diocese of Toronto will be electing a Coadjutor Bishop who will become the 12th Diocesan Bishop. (Coadjutor simply means that the elected person will be serving alongside Bishop Colin Johnson until Bishop Johnson's retirement in December 2018.) The election will require each member of Synod to discern God's call for the Church. As with all spiritual discernment, this process will involve prayerful listening, reflection, and thoughtfulness.

The Diocese of Toronto is the largest diocese in North America, home to 230 congregations with 54,000 Anglicans, also offering significant leadership both nationally and in the Global Communion. The bishop of Toronto is a central leader in: mission to our neighbours, complex administration, safeguarding the faith, unity and reconciliation, justice and outreach amongst others.

In preparation of this important moment of discernment, on June 1st our parish will participate in the diocesan day of prayer, uniting together in shared listening for the voice of the Holy Spirit. There is great blessing and power in unified prayer. Throughout the centuries, God's people have gathered in times of discernment and need, seeking God's will to be known and accomplished. I therefore invite you to join us June 1st at 10am as together we join all our Anglican family in the diocese in prayer. As well, in your own private prayers, please include the following:

Almighty and All-Present God, who delights in those who earnestly seek your will, grant to your Church the riches of wisdom and discernment, that for such a time as this, a servant-leader may be chosen who reflects the character and wisdom of Jesus Christ. May this Coadjutor Bishop be strengthened through the encouragement and power of the Holy Spirit, labour for renewal, strive for unity, and seek those isolated and far from God; we pray all these things through the name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

What is PromiseLand?



PromiseLand is our Sunday morning program where kids sing, pray and play. We explore our faith using Godly Play stories, wondering questions, hands-on materials and a shared feast. We meet in the front pew of sanctuary and move downstairs during the opening hymn. We return at The Peace and remain upstairs for the Eucharistic Prayer. After receiving

Communion or a Blessing, we go back down to the St. Nicholas Chapel to finish our story and feast. All children are most welcome!

What is the Nest?

The Nest is our Nursery for babies and toddlers. It is located on the 3rd floor (take the stairs to the left, just inside the atrium door). Please ask any of our greeters to show you the way. Our nursery supervisor and teen assistant will be there starting at 9:45am to welcome your little one!

Kids of all ages are also welcome to stay upstairs with their families for worship. We have a kids' area with books, blocks and colouring supplies by the Baptismal Font, and kids are invited to hang out there, or take something back to their pew!

What is YAL?

Young Anglican Leaders (YAL) is our youth leadership program for teens in middle and high school. Junior YAL (for teens in grades 6,7,8) meets every other Sunday from 9-9:45 for Breakfast and Bible Study. Senior YAL (for teens in high school) meets alternate Sundays from 11:30-12:30. Both groups also meet **once a month for a social event** and the **last Saturday of the month** to make and serve a hot breakfast for people in need in our community

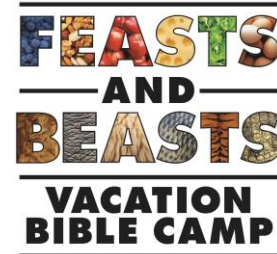
Happy Long Weekend! Both Junior and Senior YAL are cancelled today. We hope you have a terrific long weekend!
