## Children and Youth



### What is PromiseLand?

PromiseLand is our Sunday morning program where kids sing, pray and play. We explore our faith using *Godly Play* stories, wondering questions and hands-on materials. We then join the congregation in a circle around the altar for communion. All children are most welcome!

### What is YAL?

Young Anglican Leaders (YAL) is our youth leadership program for teens in middle and high school. We meet **every other Sunday** from **11:30-12:30** to read scripture, ask questions and learn about the different ways to serve in liturgy. YAL also meets **once a month for a social event** and the **last Saturday of the month** to make and serve a hot breakfast for people in need in our community.



### Upcoming Events:

After much discussion and prayer, we feel God is calling us to have the children rejoin the congregation just before the passing of the peace. During the Offertory hymn, the kids will be invited to come up and gather in a circle around the altar (like we've been doing). We believe that it's important for them to hear, see and experience the whole Eucharistic prayer, and that it is particularly powerful to be up close around the altar. The children will receive the sacrament or a blessing first and then we will go back downstairs to wrap up our lesson. This will be a transition for our kids and families, and we would love your support and prayers. Thank you!
